THE BEST

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(Gibson's protégé) is the most sought-after wedding stylist at the salon. After a complimentary consultation, he will try multiple looks and take digital photos of each for \$250. In-salon bridal updos range from \$250 to \$300. On-location styling for the bride and three other members of the bridal party costs \$1,000.

Philip Pelusi's salon is an elegant little gem in the heart of the meatpacking district. Bridal consultations are free, trials for hair and makeup start at \$250, and day-of services start at \$250. (Stylist Ricardo Gomez's on-site per diem is \$1,500 and up, and he'll travel.) Brides can also rent the entire salon for the wedding day (from \$3,000).

These Upper East Side salons, launched by this now-famous former Israeli soldier, offer sophisticated wedding-day updos and hair extensions. Prices start at \$150 for in-salon work; on-location day rates to style the bridal party range from \$1,500 to \$2,500, depending on the location and number of people. Brow master Rachel Gangemi has her own nook here, where she uses tweezers and scissors to sculpt the arches of her star-studded clientele.

WARREN-TRICOMI SALON

Tucked into the Plaza, the newest and most opulent outpost from Joel Warren and Edward Tricoli is huge at 7,000 square feet. Here, brides can get cut, colored, and styled in one fell swoop. An extensive trial-hair session (from \$450) includes two different looks with photos; the actual wedding-day do starts at \$400.

ABOUT FACE MAKEUP

During consultations, makeup artist Noelle Bonham creates a customized look for each bride and provides instruction on how to keep makeup and hair in place until the end of the reception. Bonham also offers airbrush tans and foundation coverage to hide skin flaws and tattoos. From \$400.

AMANDA SHACKLETON

It's one-stop shopping with Shackleton, who offers both hair and makeup services. Her natural technique ensures that brides look as effortless in person as they do in photos. Trials start at \$125 for hair or makeup and \$175 for both; day-of hair and makeup is \$500; each additional person is \$250.

Lilly Rivera is a pro at airbrush makeup, which makes her looks long-wearing and waterproof. A trial is \$175; day-of makeup on location is \$375 for the bride, and \$175 for each additional person (three-person minimum).

BUTTERFLY STUDIO

This Gramercy Park salon specializes in black-tie-wedding makeup—full in-salon services start at \$150, and on-location styling for the bridal party begins at \$1,500. Veteran makeup artist Francesca Roman's hand-applied makeup lasts up to ten hours with touch-ups; airbrushed makeup lasts ten to twelve.

CHEEK TO CHIC

Makeup pro Raychel Wade works closely with brides on what she calls the "You on Your Best Day" package (three-person minimum, including the bride, from \$700). Each additional person is \$150. She also offers application lessons (from \$225).

CHRISTAN BURRAN

Burran's high-fashion work has appeared in *Harper's Bazaar* and *Rolling Stone*, but she's happy to do whatever look suits the bride. On the big day, Burran soothes the bridal party with aromatherapy face massages. Trials are \$250, the bride's makeup starts at \$500, and each additional person is \$250.

For \$250 to \$400, this Bobbi Brown-trained team will ensure a smudgeproof, photo-ready bride; they also offer eyelash extensions and hair and nail services. Consultations are \$150 for the bride and bridesmaids.

The bridal package (\$500) offers unlimited styling by Dominique de Anfrasio for however many people will fit into a three-hour time frame. The same goes for makeup (\$400). For the bride alone, it's \$300 for hair and \$300 for makeup.

A five-time Emmy Award-winning makeup artist, Pearl specializes in gorgeous, organic looks. A trial is \$250 (\$100 of which goes toward the wedding-day makeup), and on-site application for three people is \$1,200. Pearl will do the rest of the bridal party for \$250 each.

FRANCESCA MANIACE

Maniace is committed to clean, precise looks that won't go out of style, and her airbrush technique ensures that the makeup will stay in place all day. A trial is \$225; wedding-day application for the bride is \$500, and from \$200 per person for the bridal party (\$175 for more than three people).

Although high-fashion looks are Nars artist Boehmer's specialty, he's equally skilled at mainstream wedding-ready makeup. Consultations start at \$200.

JESSICA LIEBESKIND MAKE-UP ARTISTRY

Brides won't find an abundance of false lashes in this makeup artist's kit. Liebeskind (a Fashion Week regular at Reem Aera, Badgley Mischka, and Amsale) likes to keep things practical, natural, and timeless. To make sure her subtle aesthetic clicks with her client's wishes, she suggests booking a "chemistry trial" (\$250). Wedding-day application from \$1,000.

JILL HARTH BEAUTY AND COSMETICS

Having spent two decades producing international beauty pageants as well as working in film and television, Harth uses airbrush techniques to transform a beleaguered complexion into a blemish-free face. A two-hour trial application is \$150. Wedding-day rates start at \$395 for the bride; \$125 for each additional client.

KERI BERMAN & CO.

Berman, whose work has been featured in previous editions of this magazine, is known for both her

friendly professionalism and her contouring and highlighting. Consultations are \$250. Wedding-day makeup for the bride and one other person by Berman is \$1,000 (other stylists are \$700); each additional person is \$200.

KIMARA AHNERT MAKEUP

Ahnert's luxe studio is perennially booked, so it's best to make appointments early—three to six months in advance. In-studio trials are \$175 with a staff member and \$200 with Ahnert. On-location work starts at \$700, or \$1,000 for Ahnert herself; there is a three-person minimum.

This pro focuses on flawless, luminous skin. Do likes to schedule trials (\$250) three to six months in advance and will travel to make up the bride on her wedding day (\$425, plus travel fee).

LAURA GELLER MAKEUP

In her sleek Upper East Side studio, Geller matches brides-to-be with her team of veteran makeup artists based on personality compatibility; an in-house wedding coordinator arranges appointments. Trials are \$125; day-of application is \$300. Brides can arrange for an artist to be on hand for touch-ups (\$150 an hour).

In an in-depth consultation session, this on-the-go makeup artist will collaborate with the bride to craft a look that will last for hours and photograph well (\$250). Wedding-day makeup starts at \$500; each additional person is \$150.

LORI HAMLIN

Working out of her Soho studio, Hamlin applies more than 120 synthetic lashes one by one—\$750 for the first application; \$250 for the relash. For wedding-day makeup with Hamlin, prices start at \$1,500 for a half day; a consultation and trial is \$350.

With more than 25 years of experience, former *Vogue* model Cole turns out fresh, flawless faces and shares personalized makeup tricks to try at home. Trials are \$200. Wedding-day makeup application for the bride and two others is \$1,000.

MAKEUP BY ANABELLE LAGUARDIA

This Laura Geller alum is known for her eye contouring (the secret is individual lash applications) and her serenity in the midst of nuptial chaos. She also does airbrushing. Consultations are \$100 per person. Day-of makeup is \$250 for the bride; each additional person is \$100.

This certified aesthetician is happy to help brides with a skin-clearing treatment or waxing regimen, and her light makeup application keeps skin from feeling layered or heavy. Trials cost \$50. She will travel anywhere for on-site applications (\$225 for the bride; \$150 for each bridesmaid). For an additional fee, she'll stay through the ceremony for touch-ups.

PIERA CANU

This Italian makeup artist, who has worked with many top fashion magazines, is known for bringing luminous looks to her clients' faces with a soft and natural base. Packages, which include the bride and two others, start at \$800; trials \$200.
